



AIID Exit Counseling Instructions (Direct Loan Recipients)

Every student who receives Student Loans through the Federal Student Aid Direct Loan program is required to go through exit counseling. This requirement was described during the application process and is an integral part of the Federal Student Aid process. AIID allows its students to complete exit counseling online, in order to become familiar with the obligation of students to manage their finances and pay back the loan money borrowed over time. However, if a student prefers instead to have a counseling session with a Financial Aid Advisor, s/he may do so by setting up an appointment with the Financial Aid office. If the student has not requested an exit counseling session in person by the time of graduation, it will be assumed that exit counseling will be completed on-line. Exit counseling should be completed within 15 days of graduating from school.

On-line Exit Counseling Instructions:

- Go online to http://www.nslds.ed.gov/nslds_SA/
- At the bottom of the page, click on the blue box that says “Exit Counseling”.
- Read the information on the resulting page and click the blue box that says “Start”.
- Read the information on each screen and click “Next” to move to the next screen, as necessary.
- When you get to the login screen, you will need to login to using your personal information, as well as the PIN number from when you originally applied for the loan.
 - If you need to look up your pin number you can go to www.pin.ed.gov and request a duplicate PIN.
- Follow the instructions and proceed through the loan counseling tutorial
